



Equipment:
Large dice (or online dice generator displayed on whiteboard), list of numbers and corresponding actions on whiteboard.

- 1: Skier: Feet together, knees bent, jump side to side, using arms.
- 2: Pirate: Climb the rigging with arms and legs.
- 3: Soldier: March on the spot with swinging arms.
- 4: Orchestra Conductor: Point fingers and swoop arms up and down and side to side.
- 5: Portrait Painter: Mime painting a canvas on an easel.
- 6: Irish Dancer: Dance the 1-2-3s.



We are big soccer fans in our class and I know it was very tough for some of you to have to learn about a Manchester United player during the week!!! Today, we will learn to play soccer like Mané!






